Tomorrow, Tuesday, February 8, the House of Representatives will begin debate on H.R. 3076, the Postal Service Reform Act. Shortly after debate ends, the House will begin voting on final passage of H.R. 3076. The NRLCA feels this legislation will bring financial stability to the Postal Service, and we urge you to contact your member of Congress ASAP and ask they vote YES on this bill.

H.R. 3076 is a bipartisan compromise bill carefully constructed to allow the Postal Service to achieve financial stability. This legislation was voted unanimously by the Oversight and Reform Committee, and now it is getting its chance on the House floor. H.R 3076 includes many provisions the NRLCA has been advocating for years. It repeals the onerous pre-funding mandate, a mandate no other agency or corporation is required to prefund. The legislation also codifies six-day mail delivery into law. Six-day service is critically important and a competitive advantage for the Postal Service, especially in rural areas where rural letter carriers deliver the "last mile." Finally, H.R. 3076 adopts private sector best practices by maximizing the integration of postal employees and retirees into Medicare.
