To maintain prompt and reliable postal services during the COVID-19 health emergency, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Delivering for America
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROMPT AND RELIABLE POSTAL SERVICES DURING
- 7 COVID-19 PANDEMIC.
- 8 (a) In General.—During the period beginning on
- 9 the date of enactment of this Act and ending on the last

day of the COVID-19 public health emergency or January 1, 2021, whichever is later, the United States Postal Service may not implement or approve any change to the oper-4 ations or the level of service provided by the Postal Service 5 from those in effect on January 1, 2020, that would impede prompt, reliable, and efficient services, including any 6 of the following actions: 8 (1) Any change in the nature of postal services 9 which will generally affect service on a nationwide or 10 substantially nationwide basis. 11 (2) Any revision of service standards. 12 (3) Any closure or consolidation of any post of-13 fice or reduction of facility hours. 14 (4) Any prohibition on payment of overtime pay 15 to Postal Service officers or employees. 16 (5) Any change that would prevent the Postal 17 Service from meeting its service standards or cause 18 a decline in measurements of performance relative to 19 those service standards. 20 (6) Any change that would have the effect of 21 delaying mail, allowing for the non-delivery of mail 22 to a delivery route, or increasing the volume of unde-23 livered mail. 24 (b) Definition of COVID-19 Public Health EMERGENCY.—In this Act, the term "COVID-19 public
