H.R. 82 the Social Security Fairness Act was signed into law on January 5, 2025

by President Joe Biden in a signing ceremony at the White House. This bipartisan legislation repeals the Windfall Elimination Provision (WEP) and the Government Pension Offset (GPO). This means that retired public service workers will now see an increase in their Social Security benefits. This includes letter carriers, firefighters, police officers and teachers.

On Tuesday, November 12, 2024 the House passed H.R. 82 with a vote of 327-75. It was then delivered to the Senate who passed it by a vote of 76-20 on Saturday, December 21, 2024.
