

## USPS OIG is Requesting Your Help

The United States Postal Service Office of Inspector General (USPS OIG) is conducting a study on how the Postal Service handles vehicle accidents and is looking for input from rural letter carriers. The goal of the study is to assess the effectiveness of the USPS' controls over reporting vehicle accidents. Specifically, the USPS OIG is looking for responses to these three questions:

1. What concerns do you have regarding the Postal Service's or your organization's administration or management of vehicle accidents?
2. How does your organization account for accidents that are not being reported timely?
3. What changes would you make to improve the process of vehicle accident reporting?
