

TAKE ACTION!

Beginning in June, the Senate will consider the Reconciliation Bill passed by the House on May 22 by a vote of 215-214. This bill currently includes significant cuts to the retirement benefits that postal and federal employees have **earned** through years of hard work, dedication, and sacrifice.

WHAT WOULD THESE BENEFIT CUTS MEAN?

Elimination of FERS Annuity Supplement: The FERS Retirement Supplement provides a temporary benefit to eligible postal employees who retire before age 62. It serves as a bridge between retirement and the commencement of Social Security benefits.

Civil Service Protections Trade-Off: Requires new federal employees to choose between becoming at-will employees and foregoing the benefits and protections of collective bargaining or contributing an additional 5% toward their FERS annuity.*

*does not directly affect rural carriers
